#### **BACKGROUND**

This family took a year to go sailing during which their daughters were homeschooled aboard their family yacht in preparation for entrance exams for the top London private girls' schools. A teaching couple were appointed to ensure all subjects could be covered for all three students in a way that complemented the learning environment without compromising educational rigour.

## OUTCOME

All three girls were accepted to their first-choice schools. The girls all enjoyed engaging with topics related to their travel, in particular marine animals – sea turtles and dolphins!



"Every other Friday they have a Regional Module, where they work with the tutors on the geography, history and culture of the country we are in. They had decided last week that they would put on a Greek play, using their knowledge from Pompeii combined with research into Greek life and mythology. ## CASE STUDY TWO

- 6 months
- 2 students: 4 and 5 years old
- 1 full-time tutor (Marine Scientist, Diving Instructor)
- Morning for academics; afternoons for activities
- South Pacific itinerary

## **BACKGROUND**

This family took their children out of a top London preparatory school for one term to enjoy the maiden voyage of their yacht around the South Pacific. The tutor was charged with ensuring the children were kept up to date with their peers, as well as using the many locations as enriching learning opportunities with particular emphasis on the marine environment.

## OUTCOME

As well as reintegrating seamlessly into their school, both boys learned to snorkel, kayak, and dive. The family continued to enlist one of our tutors for other trips over the years.
